Professional Development Workshops

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

This is a call for proposals for the **Professional Development Workshops** component of the ISPSO 2011 Annual Meeting. The Professional Development Workshops take place June 13th – 16th 2011.

This call is being made to ISPSO members only.

Workshop program

1. Six one-day and three two-day workshops are planned.
2. The audience will comprise ISPSO members and non-members whose work roles include consultants, academics, organisational leaders and managers, and students. We expect strong demand from local practitioners, many of whom will be aware of the field through university studies and related professional activities in the region.
3. The aim is to offer workshops and masterclasses that will attract people both new to the field and those more experienced.
4. Presenters will include ISPSO members and invited professionals.

Criteria for workshop selection

Proposals will be assessed on the following criteria:

- a) Clearly show how the proposed workshop is relevant to the development of professional skills, knowledge and practice in the field of psychoanalytic study of organisations.
- b) Methodology for professional learning is commensurate with anticipated needs of intended audience and learning aims of the workshop.
- c) The stated minimum and maximum number of participants for a workshop.

Practical information

Proposals will be assessed by Jinette de Gooijer (PDW chair) and John Newton. The results of the assessment will be advised to all by 31 October 2010.

Presenters receive a stipend (A\$900 per workshop day¹) and reimbursement of 1 or 2 night's accommodation. All workshop presenters are expected to enter into a formal contract with the ISPSO 2011 Annual Meeting organisation. Details of the contract are available on request.
